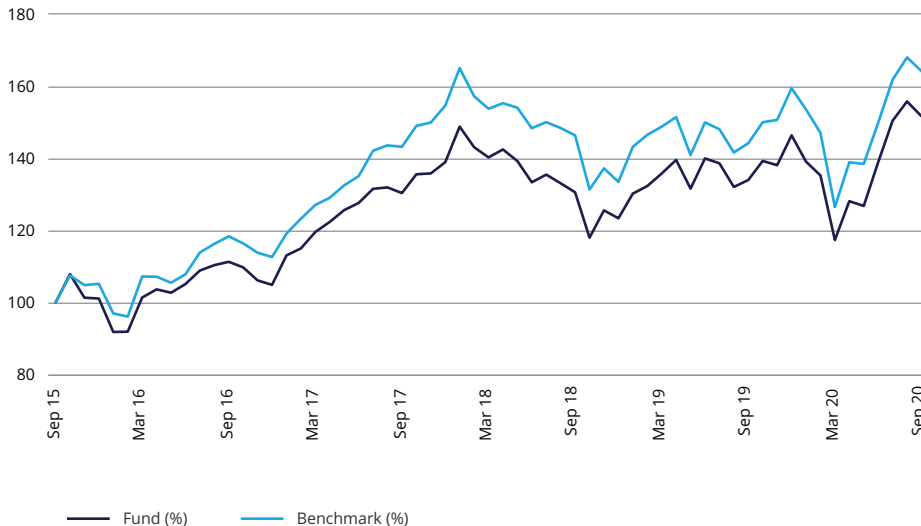
## Important Information
